By-law No. L.T.C	

A by-law to repeal sections 1, 2 and 3 of By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being, "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons."

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS on December 16, 1991 the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacted By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons.";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to repeal By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being, "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons.", passed on December 16, 1991 are repealed.
- 2. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed
