By-law No. L.T.C.- _____

A by-law to repeal sections 1, 2 and 3 of By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being, "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons."

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS on December 16, 1991 the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacted By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons.";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to repeal By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of By-law No. L.T.C.-52-13, being, "A by-law to provide for entering into an arrangement with the London Transit Commission with respect to reduced bus fares for elderly persons.", passed on December 16, 1991 are repealed.
2. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed
