BACKGROUND

On February 3, 2017, Municipal Council resolved that...

e) ... the Civic Administration BE DIRECTED to bring forward any reports required for submission under the AODA to the Municipal Council, for its review, prior to submission.

LEGISLATIVE REQUIREMENTS

Under the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*, a compliance report is required to be submitted to the Accessibility Directorate of Ontario ('ADO') by a designated public sector organization, such as the City of London, every two years and the reports must be available to the public. Compliance reports are currently posted on the City of London's London.ca website.

The compliance report format is determined by the ADO and released to organizations in advance for review, certification, and submission by the deadline associated with each organization.

2017 ACCESSIBILITY COMPLIANCE REPORT

The City of London is required to submit the 2017 Accessibility Compliance Report to the ADO by December 31st, 2017. Civic Administration developed a process whereby all Service Areas review the applicable Compliance Report at the beginning of the year and confirm compliance at time of submission. The <u>attached</u> 2017 Accessibility Compliance Report (Appendix A) has been completed, based on consultation with applicable Service Areas, and is now available for review prior to submission.
