Re: Ontario's Draft Guidelines on Permitted Uses in Ontario's Prime Agricultural Areas

At its meeting held on March 18, 2015, the Agricultural Advisory Committee (AAC) asked that the following actions be taken with respect to Ontario's Draft Guidelines on Permitted Uses in Ontario's Prime Agricultural Areas document:

- a) the Civic Administration **BE ADVISED** that the Agricultural Advisory Committee (AAC) indicated, that in its opinion, a minimum set-back should be maintained between livestock operations and other land uses, which would alleviate the potential of nuisance complaints, such as odors; and,
- b) it **BE NOTED** that the AAC reviewed and received a communication dated February 2015 from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs, and heard a verbal delegation from L. Maitland, Planner I, with respect to this matter. (2/4/AAC)
