- Enhances neighbourhood sense of place and identity
- Encourages physical recreation in parks and along pathways
- Shadier and cooler streets promote walking and playing outside
- Respiratory disease is decreased
- Mental health is improved with exposure to nature
- ✓ Well-treed streets even experience less crime
- ✓ Well-treed commercial areas attract more shoppers who shop for longer
- Enhances our resilience to climate change impacts
- Trees and natural areas are big component of quality of life. Quality of life attracts mobile workforce talent.
