Idea Name: Grand Theatre Expansion

Organization: Grand Theatre

Description: We are proposing to expand The Grand Theatre into the parking lot off Dufferin and incorporate a 400-seat theatre, additional rehearsal, wardrobe, classroom, office space and a 1200-seat concert hall space. Parking is also included in the initial plans. This will provide London with a world class Cultural Centre that will be a destination performing arts hub.

Status: we have had preliminary meetings with land owners, city manager, Mayor, councillors, private investors and possible arts partners including Orchestra London.
