The stately home located at 1576 Richmond Street was built c.1926. On May 28, 2012, the Planning Committee will consider two things: a request to demolish the property by the new owner versus a request for Heritage Designation from City of London Staff.

We urge the members of the Planning Committee to recommend the Heritage Designation to save this beautiful Tudor home. Demolishing the home and then building a multi-residence structure will forever change the property and the area. Proximity to The University of Western Ontario does not mean everything needs to automatically become a student residence!

Further, if a multi-residence property is built, the resulting added traffic will exacerbate an already congested traffic situation.
