- The identification of future opportunities and directions.

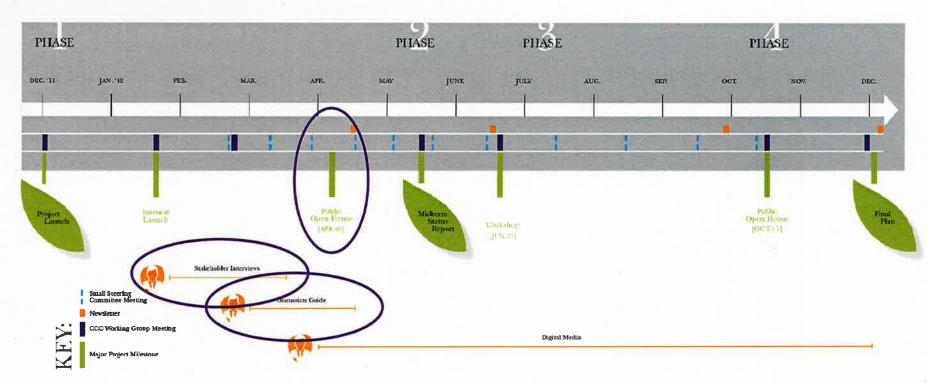
