- c) That approval hereby given **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into negotiations for satisfactory prices, terms and conditions with Navistar Canada Incorporated to the satisfaction of the Acting Executive Director, Planning, Environmental & Engineering Services & City Engineer; and
- d) Approval hereby given **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract or having a purchase order relating to the subject matter of this approval.

# **BACKGROUND**

### **Purchasing Process**

In 2011 purchases totalled \$174,433 (excluding HST). Products will be purchased into inventory as and when required for use on approximately 80 City fleet vehicles and 3 Fire Department Apparatus. Funding for the Navistar OEM replacement parts is provided in the 2012 Current Operating Budget.

Navistar Canada Incorporated is the manufacturer and has established an authorized local distributor; Carrier Centres, located at 90 Enterprise Drive, London, ON N6N 1A8, thus there is only one vendor for these products in South-Western Ontario.

The City qualifies for a National Fleet Pricing discount based on the volume of our fleet and our total annual spend in maintenance and replacement parts. All shipping and or freight costs have been absorbed by Carrier Centers and are provided at no additional charge for local or international deliveries to us.

This recommendation is in compliance with our 'Procurement of Goods and Service Policy' as per Section 14.4 Single Source, clauses d and e.

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## **Financial Impact**

There are no additional operating costs associated with this project.
