My client owns a number of properties in the area to which the proposed Near Campus Neighbourhood Official Plan Amendment policies and related Zoning Bylaw Amendment would apply. My client is opposed to these policies and the Zoning By-law Amendment for a number of reasons which have been expressed by him and by others.
