<b>SUBJECT</b>	<b>TENDER 12-64 ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE SERVICES</b>
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	

That on the recommendation of the Managing Director - Corporate Assets, the following actions **BE TAKEN** with respect to Tender 12-64:

- a) That the bid submitted by Schindler Elevator Corporation, 4056 Meadowbrook Pl., Unit 115, London, Ontario N6L 1E2 **BE ACCEPTED**, at their tender price of \$548,366.40, HST extra, for a five (5) year period, it being noted that Schindler Elevator Corporation submitted the lowest bid and meets the City's terms, conditions and specifications of Tender 12-64;
- b) That Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all the administrative acts that are necessary in connection with this contract; and
- c) Approval hereby given **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract or having a purchase order relating to the subject matter of this approval.

<b>BACKGROUND</b>
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**Purchasing Process**

Four (4) bids were received May 23, 2012 as a result of this tender call and are summarized in Appendix "A" attached.

Schindler Elevator Corporation was the low bid and meets all the terms, conditions and specifications of Tender 12-64.

**Purpose**

The tender was developed to solicit responses for Elevator Maintenance Services in accordance with the current edition of CAN/CSA-B44 Safety Code for Elevators & Escalators and the current edition of CAN/CSA-B355 Lifts for Persons with Disabilities.

**Financial Impact**

Funding for this project has been provided in various departmental operating budgets.
