<b>BACKGROUND</b>

Municipal Council at the July 25, 2011 meeting passed the attached resolution referring a request from Councillor S. Orser with respect for the renaming and dedication of the Quebec Street Bridge to the “Wolseley Bridge” to the Civic Administration for a report back at a future meeting of the Community and Neighbourhoods Committee.

This request has been considered in accordance with Council Policy 3(7A) being the “Naming/Renaming or Dedicating of Municipal Property, buildings and Park Elements Policy”. The Municipal Addressing Advisory Group does not support the request given that there is a Wolseley Avenue located in the downtown area and there is concerned that in an emergency situation there may be confusion with the apparent duplication of names.
