Hi Sandy - I understand that EEPAC wants some clarification on the SLSR and EIS and process related to the above site/subdivision.

- The Subject Land Status Report was a requirement of the complete application for subdivision as a result of pre consultation for the file.
- After review of the initial SLSR it became clear that an EIS would also be required for the site
- We met with the applicant and consultants in January to go over the requirements of the EIS
- In the interim, the Consultants (NRSI) submitted a response to the SLSR comments
- We indicated that going forward and for ease of review, we wanted to see the EIS and SLSR as one document, and include any SLSR responses/responses in this document. This allows for me to circulate it as one document and get responses back in one comprehensive review. Otherwise it will be difficult to keep track and get responses from the agencies in a timely fashion and keep the review rolling when documents come in at different times.

The comments, therefore, that were on the EEPAC agenda as responses to the SLSR from NRSI – EEPAC can review and provide comments if they like, or they can wait until the updated EIS/SLSR is provided and provide more comprehensive responses to that.

I spoke with Sifton and they indicated the revised EIS/SLSR and hydrogeological study will be submitted in the next few weeks, so EEPAC should see something on their agenda either in May or June.

Hopefully that clarifies. If my attendance is still needed at EEPAC please let me know.
