- Services Bradley, Newbold, Wilton Grove area
- Runs five times from 6:27 am until 8:51 am (every 40 minutes)
- Runs another seven times from 2:24 pm to 5:24 pm.
- No service after 5:24 pm.
- No mid-afternoon service.
- Only runs Monday through Friday.
- The route varies between the morning runs and the afternoon runs.
- Morning run services 158 businesses.
- Evening run services 140 businesses.

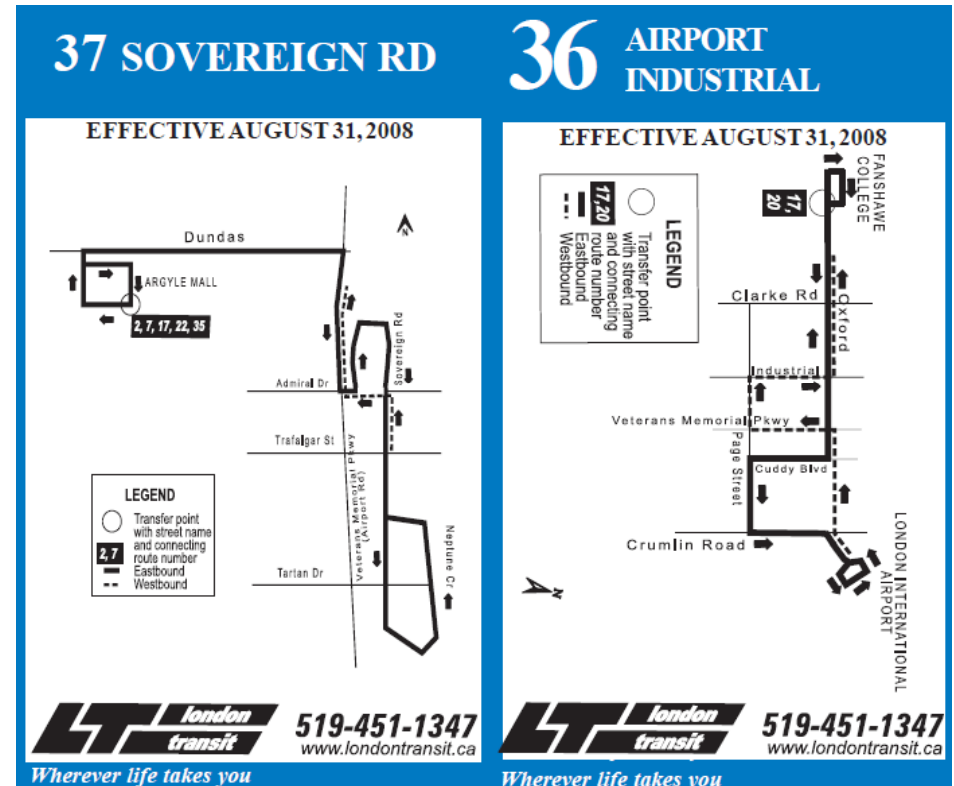

Routes #36 Airport Industrial and #37 Sovereign Rd

- Together, service the industrial areas located beyond Clarke Rd in the east end of the city.
- Route 36 runs seven times between 6:10 am and 8:35 am (every 30 minutes).
- Route 36 then runs seven more times between 2:29 pm and 5:29 pm.
- It then runs twice more between 10:36 pm and 11:09 pm.
- Route 37 runs four times between 6:27 am and 8:27 am.
- It starts running again at 3:38 pm and runs four more times until 4:58 pm.
- Route 37 does not run at night.
- Between the two routes, there is no service between 8:30 am and 2:30 pm.
- Route 36 services 48 businesses including the airport.
- Route 37 services 103 businesses.

But what will this do?

- Businesses in these industrial areas are frequently seeking new employees. However, poor transportation in the area leads many employers to require that employees have their own transportation to get to work.
- This can be a major deterrent to people looking for work in the area. Many will feel that they would make more on EI than they would by having to take a cab to and from work every day.
- Regional unemployment is at 8.9%. In order to combat this growing number, we must look at alternative solutions to encourage employment growth in the city.

This proposal will open up new doors to the city's unemployed and under-employed. More jobs will be able to be filled, workplaces will have to spend less time trying to fill positions. Good transit infrastructure is also a very lucrative factor in attracting new businesses to the city. This will also allow the opportunity for those struggling to keep a vehicle on the road a low-cost alternative. This would free up money that would be spent back into the local economy.
