

SUBJECT:	LOCAL RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY GENERATION PROJECTS SEEKING ONTARIO FEED-IN TARIFF CONTRACTS

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Development and Compliance Services and Chief Building Official, the following actions be taken with respect to local renewable electricity generation projects seeking Ontario Feed-In-Tariff (FIT) Contracts:

- a) pursuant to section 13.8 of the Council Procedure By-law, the actions of the Municipal Council taken at its meeting held on July 24 and 25, 2012, with respect to clause 5 of the 20th Report of the Planning and Environment Committee, related to the approval of forms for Municipal Support Resolutions under the Province's FIT Program BE RECONSIDERED as the Ontario Power Authority (OPA) has subsequently released prescribed forms related to this Program;
- b) the said Clause 5 of the 20th Report of the Planning and Environment Committee from its meeting held on July 23, 2012 **BE RESCINDED**; and,
- the Civic Administration **BE DIRECTED** to undertake the following actions with respect to proposed changes (Program Rules) to the Feed-in-Tariff (FIT) Program, operated by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA):
 - i) undertake the process described in the recommendations below when the Draft FIT Program Rules (April 5, 2012), which are designed to assist renewable energy project developers obtain timely Municipal Council Support Resolutions, are finalized in the very near future; it being noted that if the FIT Program Rules are substantially changed when finalized, the Civic Administration will revise these recommendations and resubmit, if required;
 - A) co-ordinate and review all requests for a Municipal Council Support Resolution and determine if the request(s) fall into Category 1 Projects (all rooftop solar anywhere in London), Category 2 Projects (ground-mounted solar at specific locations in London) or Category 3 Projects (significant FIT projects, such as wind, biomass and biogas at specific locations in London);
 - B) for Category 1 Projects, the proposed resolution that the construction and operation of rooftop solar projects, having little or no potential for impacts on adjacent properties, be supported without reservation anywhere in London where permitted by the Province of Ontario's Feed-In Tariff (FIT) Program rules be approved, as set out in the Municipal Council Blanket Support Resolution attached hereto as Appendix "A";
 - C) for Category 2 Projects, the proposed resolution that the construction and operation of ground-mounted solar projects, having little or no potential for impacts on adjacent properties, be supported at a specific location(s) identified by the project developer where permitted by the Province of Ontario's Feed-In Tariff (FIT) Program rules be approved as a two step process:



- i) the Civic Administration prepare a recommendation report to the appropriate Standing Committee, commenting on the proposed location; and,
- ii) if supported by the Civic Administration, submit a Municipal Council Support Resolution <u>attached</u> hereto as Appendix "B" as part of the report to the appropriate Standing Committee; and,
- D) for Category 3 Projects, the Civic Administration will review and offer recommendations to Council on the required steps for undertaking these types of projects and opportunities for a Municipal Council Support Resolution;
- E) co-ordinate the Municipal Council Support Resolution process through the Development & Compliance Division; it being noted that liaison will take place with the Civic Administration from the Land Use Planning Division and Environmental & Engineering Services;
- the Mayor and the City Clerk **BE AUTHORIZED** to sign any requested Council Resolution for Category 1 Projects using the Municipal Council Blanket Support Resolution (Appendix "A"); it being noted that these recommendations are solely for the purpose of enabling an applicant of the FIT Program to receive priority points under the new FIT Program rules, and may not be used for the purpose of any other form of municipal approval in relation to the application or project or any other purpose; and,
- e) the Civic Administration **BE DIRECTED** to take the necessary action to provide notice of the proposed fee schedule for processing Category 2 and Category 3 FIT applications and an amendment to Planning Fees By-law CP-18 to be considered at a future Public Participation Meeting before the appropriate Standing Committee.

PREVIOUS REPORTS PERTINENT TO THIS MATTER


July 23, 2012 – Report to the Planning and Environment Committee – Municipal Support Resolutions for Local Renewable Electricity Generation Projects Seeking Ontario Feed-in-Tariff Contracts.

PURPOSE

The report is provided to replace the previously Council approved forms for Municipal Support Resolutions under the Province's FIT Program with new prescribed forms provided by the Ontario Power Authority. The report also recommends amendments to the Planning Fees Bylaw CP-18 to implement a proposed fee structure for the processing of applications for municipal support under the FIT Program.

DISCUSSION

As a result of proposed changes to the Provincial FIT Program operated by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA), staff brought forward a recommendation report to Planning and Environment Committee on July 23, 2012 to establish a process for civic administration to implement the FIT Program requirements. The recommendations were approved at the July 24 and 25, 2012 meeting of Municipal Council, including two standardized forms prepared by staff for the purpose of Municipal Support Resolutions. Subsequently, the OPA has released prescribed forms for both a Blanket Municipal Support Resolution and individual project Municipal Support Resolutions for use by Ontario municipalities.



The new prescribed forms are attached as Appendices "A" and "B". These forms are to replace the previously approved standardized resolutions included as Appendices "A" and "B" of the July 23, 2012 Planning and Environment Committee Report.

Staff from Development and Compliance Services will coordinate the FIT Program for the City of London. Staff have developed an application form for applicants to use when requesting Municipal Support under the FIT Program. The "Renewable Energy Project Application" form is attached as Appendix "C". The proposed application form will provide staff with the base information necessary to receive, track and liaise proposed applications.

There are four categories of applications under the FIT Program. Staff have considered the various file types to determine the administrative and logistical requirements for each. The MicroFIT and Category 1 projects have administrative needs similar to issuance of Lawyers Letters in that a request is received and documentation is provided. Category 2 projects by definition have little or no impact on adjacent properties but still require preparation of a PEC report and issuance of the prescribed Municipal Support Resolution form. Category 3 projects are more involved and require preparation of a PEC report to review the proposal and offer recommendations to Council on the consideration of these types of projects for Municipal Support Resolution.

City staff have considered the work involved and the financial impact to applicants and are proposing a fee structure for processing FIT applications as shown in Table 1 below.

Notes:

- 1. microFIT and FIT Category 1 compliance form turnaround not to exceed two weeks.
- 2. FIT Category 1 compliance form to be accompanied by blanket municipal council resolution.
- 3. Building permits are required for all rooftop installations.

Fees for Micro FIT and FIT – Category 1 projects are already in place and can be applied at this time. For the Category 2 and Category 3 projects, notice must be provided prior to amending to Planning Fees By-law CP-18 and the proposed amendment must be brought back for consideration at a future public meeting before it is enacted. This action is proposed in recommendation clause c).

CONCLUSION

Following Council Approval of the proposed recommendations, all new requests for renewable energy projects would require the attached application form. The proposed process is intended to provide for consistent, timely responses to these requests as it is anticipated that Developers will be working with a very short time frame to pull together the necessary points to submit their applications to the OPA.

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Public notice must be provided before the proposed application fees for the municipal review process can be adopted for Category 2 and Category 3 FIT projects. Before the fees are introduced, proposed changes to Planning Fees By-law CP-18 will be advertised and brought back to a future public meeting for consideration.
