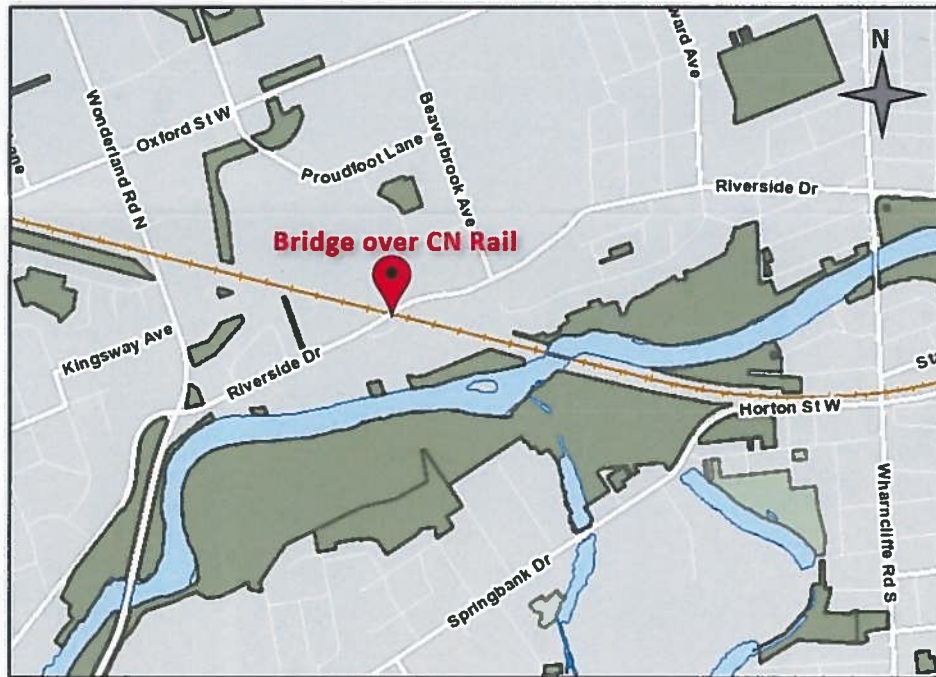




NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT
Rehabilitation of Riverside Drive Bridge over the CN Railway
Detailed Design, Tendering and Contract Administration



The City of London is carrying out the detailed design, tendering process and contract administration for the rehabilitation of the Riverside Drive bridge over the CN railway, located approximately 750m east of Wonderland Road North. The rehabilitation will extend the overall life of the structure and includes replacement of the concrete deck overlay, replacement of expansion joint seals, and concrete patch repairs in areas exhibiting deterioration. The existing roadway cross section will be maintained with bike lanes, curb and sidewalk.



The study is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements for Schedule 'A+' projects within the Municipal Class EA document (2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015), under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. Schedule A+ projects are pre-approved under the Municipal Class EA.

A Public Update Meeting (PUM) will be held near the 90% design completion to highlight the traffic management and construction staging strategies, potential impacts to utilities/services and the environment, as well as the proposed mitigation measures. Notification of date, time, and location for the PUM will be provided closer to the date.
