SUBJECT	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW

RECOMMENDATION


That on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Engineering and City Engineer, the <u>attached</u> proposed by-law (Appendix "A") **BE INTRODUCED** at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on October 30, 2012 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S. 111).

BACKGROUND

The Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S.111) requires amendments (Appendix "A") to address traffic safety, operations and parking concerns. The following amendments are proposed:

1. No Parking

- a) Due to safety concerns with narrow street width and vehicles parking on both sides of Cardigan Place it is proposed to create a No Parking Anytime zone on the north side of the street from Cardigan Drive to the west end of the street (east limit of cul-de-sac). When vehicles are parked on both sides the road becomes too narrow for drivers to navigate and emergency vehicles to access the street. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).
- b) Gainsborough Road was recently reconstructed between Wonderland Road North and Whiteacres Drive. New curbs were added and the road width reduced. It is necessary to prohibit parking on one side of the street to accommodate for this change. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).
- c) Due to safety concerns with vehicles parking within the curves on Exmouth Circle, it is proposed to create a No Parking Anytime zones on the inside of the curve. Concerns have been expressed that if vehicles are parked on the inside of the curve the visibility is greatly reduced. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).
- d) Municipal staff received complaints that when vehicles are parked on City streets adjacent to traffic island within the limits of cul-de-sac it is difficult for residents to access their driveways and it prevents large vehicles such as moving or garbage trucks from navigating the cul-de-sac. It is proposed to amend Section 10 (No Parking in posted locations) to prohibit parking adjacent to traffic island within the limit of cul-de-sacs.
- e) Sir. Winston Churchill School on Merlin Crescent was recently closed. It is recommended to remove No Stopping and School Bus Loading Zone in front of the school. Amendments are required to Schedule 1 (No Stopping) and Schedule 16 (School Bus Loading Zones).
- f) Parking bays with curb extensions were constructed on the west side of Repton Avenue as a traffic calming measure. On-street parking should be prohibited in the narrow areas of the street. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).



g) Parking bays with curb extensions were constructed on the south side of Hawthorne Road as a part of traffic calming measure. On-street parking should be prohibited in the narrow areas of the street. It is also necessary to update the limits of No Parking Anytime zone as subdivision is fully developed. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).

2. Regulatory Signs

a) Due to ongoing safety concerns with respect to traffic operation at the intersection of Veronica Avenue/King Edward Avenue and private driveway it is proposed to install new stop sign on King Edward Avenue to clearly define right-of-way.

An Amendment is required to Schedule 10 (Entering Highway – Stop Signs).

3. Revised Speed Limits

a) An operational review of Wellington Road South at Glanworth Road recommended a speed reduction from the current 80 km/hr to 70 km/hr through the curves.

An amendment is required to Schedule 17 (Higher Speed Limits) to incorporate the above and to correct road naming errors.



APPENDIX "A" BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (P.S. 111)

Bill No.

By-law No. PS-111

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. No Stopping

Schedule "1" (No Stopping) of the said By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by **deleting** the following row:


2. No Parking

Schedule "2" (No Parking) of the said By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by **deleting** the following rows:

Gainsborough Road	South	A point 370 m west of Aldersbrook Rd	A point 90 m east of Wonderland Rd N	Anytime
Hawthorne Road	North	West end of the street	Blackacres Blvd	Anytime
Repton Avenue	West	Firefly Drive	Phillbrook Drive	Anytime

Northbound King Edward Avenue Veronica Avenue

4. School Bus Loading Zones

Schedule "16" (School Bus Loading Zones) of the said By-law PS-111is hereby amended is hereby amended by **deleting** the following rows:

Merlin Crescent West Churchill Ave Park Ave

5. <u>Higher Speed Limits</u>

Schedule "17" (Higher Speed Limits) of the said By-law PS-111is hereby amended is hereby amended by **deleting** the following rows:

Wellington Road	A point 300 m south of Commissioners Road	A point 50 m south of Dingman Drive	60 km/h
Wellington Road	A point 50 m south of Dingman Drive	Scotland Drive	70 km/r
Wellington Road	Scotland Drive	South City Limits	80 km/h


And by **adding** the following rows:

Section 10 (No Parking in Posted Locations), Subsection 1 of the said By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by adding the following row:

(j) Immediately adjacent to an inner curb within a cul-de-sac, where a cul-de-sac is constructed with an inner and outer curb



7. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
