RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Managing Director - Corporate Assets;

- (a) The bid submitted by Sierra Construction (Woodstock) Ltd., 1401 Dundas Street, Woodstock, Ontario N4S 8X8 at its quoted price of \$106,182 (HST excluded) for the Nichols Recreation Centre Dressing Room Upgrades **BE ACCEPTED**; it being pointed out that the bid submitted by Sierra Construction (Woodstock) Ltd. was lowest of ten (10) bids received and meets the City's specifications and requirements in all areas;
- (b) The financing for this project **BE APPROVED** as set out in the Sources of Financing Report attached as Appendix "A";
- (c) The Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all administrative acts which are necessary in connection with the project; and
- (d) The approvals given herein **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract with the contractor for the work.

BACKGROUND

PURPOSE:


This report is submitted to seek Council approval to enter into a formal contract with Sierra Construction (Woodstock) Ltd. for the Nichols Recreation Centre Dressing Room Upgrades.

CONTEXT:

The scope of work is to upgrade the eight (8) change rooms that support the two (2) original ice pads that were constructed in 1984. The work briefly consists of:

- Skate tile replacement;
- Painting;
- Lighting upgrades;
- Washroom fixture replacement; and
- Refurbishment of the shower stalls.

The work is scheduled to be completed over the winter months with two (2) dressing rooms being out of service at any given time and it is expected the will work take four (4) months to complete.



DISCUSSION:

Request for Quotation (RFQ) 11-62 was issued on September 7, 2011 with the responses received on September 26, 2011. All ten (10) bids received exceeded the \$100,000 RFQ limit and as per the Procurement of Goods and Services Policy requires City Council's approval as per Policy Section 12.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:
