SUBJECT:	CONTRACT AWARD – TENDER NO. T11-62 FOX HOLLOW COMMUNITY SWM SYSTEM (HEARD DRAIN) AND TRUNK SANITARY SEWER(ES3019 / ES5236)

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Director, Wastewater and Treatment, Planning, Environmental and Engineering Services, the following action **BE TAKEN** with respect to the award of a contract for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer Construction:


- (a) The bid submitted by Ingerwood Construction Ltd. at its tendered price of \$4,502,006.40 excluding H.S.T., for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer Construction contract, **BE ACCEPTED**; it being pointed out that the bid submitted by Ingerwood Construction Ltd. was the lowest of Seven (7) bids received and meets the City's specifications and requirements in all areas;
- the engineering fees for Stantec Consulting **BE INCREASED** by \$404,910 to carry out the Inspection and General Construction Administration (\$325,930) and monitoring program (\$78,980) for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) and Trunk Sanitary Sewer Construction project, it being noted that this increases the original estimated upset limit to \$1,308,430, excluding HST noting that this firm completed the engineering design, based upon the Fee Guideline for Professional Engineering Services, 2006, recommended by the Ontario Society of Professional Engineers; and in accordance with Section 15.2 (g) of the Procurement of Goods and Services Policy;
- (c) the financing for this work **BE APPROVED** as set out in the Sources of Financing Report attached hereto as Appendix "A";
- (d) the consulting fees for the project identified in (a) above, **BE IN ACCORDANCE** with the estimate on file, which are based upon the Fee Guideline for Professional Engineering Services, 2006, recommended by the Ontario Society of Professional Engineers;
- (e) the Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all the administrative acts that are necessary in connection with this work;
- (f) the approvals given herein **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract with the consultant for the work; and
- (g) the Mayor and City Clerk **BE AUTHORIZED** to execute any contract or other documents, if required, to give effect to these recommendations.

BACKGROUND

Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to award the construction contract for the construction of the Fox Hollow Community Stormwater Management (SWM) System (Heard Drain) and Trunk Sanitary Sewer (ES3019/ES5236) and to recommend that the City's Consultant (Stantec Consulting) carry out the inspection and contract administration necessary to complete and construct the project (location map is shown in Appendix B).

Context:

The Addendum to the Fox Hollow Development Area Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA Addendum) for Storm/Drainage, Stormwater management and Sanitary Servicing was completed in April 2010. The EA Addendum recommended that a linear Heard Drain SWM facility be constructed to provide on-line erosion control storage as well as conveying storm/drainage flows from the Fox Hollow Development Area. In conjunction with the SWM facilities in the Fox Hollow Development Area the on-line erosion control storage in the Heard Drain SWM facility mitigates land use change in the Fox Hollow Development Area such that there is no increase in erosion potential in Snake Creek. The EA also recommended that the trunk sanitary sewer be constructed within the Heard Drain corridor to service the Fox Hollow Development Area. Stantec was engaged in May 2010 to commence the functional and detailed design in accordance with the EA Addendum.

The current construction project involves the construction of the east to west section of the Heard Drain linear SWM facility and includes approximately 150,000 cubic metres of cut material to be removed from the site as well as the installation of approximately 1045 metres of sanitary sewers. It is noted that as per the recommendations of the EA Addendum approximately 620 lineal metres of the Heard Drain linear SWM facility will be located up to 100 metres north of its present location in recognition that the relocation of the Heard Drain would provide more efficient and desirable land development planning and a better lot pattern in keeping with the City's planning objectives as well as accommodate the allocation for a school block for the Fox Hollow Development Area.

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Discussion:

In July 2011, the City acquired the land for SWM Facilities No. 2, 3, the Heard Drain SWM facility and the Fox Hollow trunk sanitary sewer. It is noted that a blanket easement over the lands adjacent to the SWM facilities is in effect that allows the City to undertake all works for these project. The work for this contract is anticipated to be completed in July 2012 please refer to Tables 1 and 2 Appendix 'C' that includes reports required in support of the works, anticipated contract awards and construction completion dates.

Tenders for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer construction were opened on Tuesday, October 4, 2011.

Seven (7) contractors submitted tenders as follows:

All tenders have been checked by the Finance Department and Planning, Environmental and Engineering Services Department and the top three tenders were checked by Stantec Consulting. The tender estimate just prior to tender opening was \$4,814,877 (excluding 13% H.S.T.). All tenders include a contingency allowance of \$450,000 (excluding 13% H.S.T.).

Stantec has completed the functional and detailed design for this facility and has demonstrated extensive knowledge of City's storm/drainage and SWM infrastructure requirements within the drainage area. As such, Stantec is recommended to proceed with the inspection, general construction administration and monitoring for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer project. The engineering fees approved to date for this project associated with the EA Addendum (\$122,900), functional and detailed design for SWM facilities Nos. 1, 2, 3, Heard Drain and Trunk Sanitary Sewer (\$641,000) and contract administration, supervision and monitoring for the construction of SWM Facility No. 2 (\$139,620) total approximately \$903,520. The contract administration, site supervision (\$314,930) and monitoring (\$89,980) fees for the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer project are \$404,910 for a total upset limit of engineering fees of \$1,308,430 excluding HST. It is further anticipated that Stantec will be awarded the contract administration and site inspection of SWM facilities Nos. 1 and 3 and associated drainage works in 2012 given their involvement in the EA Addendum and design of these works to date this being subject to satisfactory completion of the current works.

Conclusions:

It is recommended that Ingerwood Construction Ltd. be awarded the Construction of the Fox Hollow Community SWM System (Heard Drain) & Trunk Sanitary Sewer construction contract and that the City's consultant (Stantec Consulting) be authorized to carry out the inspection, contract administration and monitoring for this project.


