By-law No. A

A by-law to appoint livestock and poultry valuers for the City of London for the purposes of the Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act, 1990.

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 3 of the *Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act* (the "Act") provides that, where a dog kills or injures livestock or poultry, the municipality is liable to the owner of the livestock or poultry for the amount determined pursuant to the Act;

AND WHEREAS section 4 of the Act requires a municipality to appoint livestock and poultry valuers to carry out the provisions of the Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. The following individual is hereby appointed as a livestock and poultry valuer for the City of London for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the *Protection of Livestock* and *Poultry from Dogs Act*:

- 2. Each valuer appointed herein shall be paid \$50.00 for each attendance and for each necessary reattendance. In addition, each valuer shall be entitled to the applicable travel allowance prescribed by the City of London's Travel & Business Expense Policy.
- 3. By-law No. A.-5324-61, and its amendments, are hereby repealed.
- 4. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
