SUBJECT:	GLANWORTH MUNICIPAL DRAIN - 2011

RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Director of Wastewater and Treatment, Planning, Environmental and Engineering Services, this report **BE RECEIVED** and reported to Municipal Council for their information:

- a) The drainage report, prepared by Spriet Associates London Limited, Consulting Engineers, for the construction of the Glanworth Municipal Drain – 2011 (ES4822 and ES4825) at an estimated cost of \$405,200.00, excluding HST, **BE ADOPTED**; and
- b) The proposed by-law attached as Appendix 'B' **BE INTRODUCED** at the Council meeting on November 7, 2011 and **BE GIVEN** two readings to authorize the construction of the Glanworth Municipal Drain – 2011 project, it being noted that the third reading and enactment of the by-law would occur after the holding of the Court of Revision in connection with the project. It further being noted that a tender for these works will be issued upon approval and final award of the works will be submitted to Council for approval.

PREVIOUS REPORTS PERTINENT TO THIS MATTER
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ETC – May 10, 2010 – The appointment of Spriet Associates for the reconstruction of the Glanworth Municipal Drain.

BACKGROUND

Purpose:

The Drainage Act requires a Council resolution to authorize the construction of the Municipal Drain project. Approval of the recommendation will serve this purpose.

Context:

The drainage report for the Glanworth Municipal Drain was prepared pursuant to Sections 4 and 78 of the Drainage Act 9 (please see location map attached). The work was initiated by a petition signed by the owners whose land contains over 60 percent of the area requiring drainage. Their requests for drainage improvements were studied by Spriet Associates London Limited and are documented in the Engineer's Report. It included technical specifications for construction, cost estimates and an assessment of costs to benefiting property owners, in accordance with the Drainage Act.

A copy of the report has been provided to the landowners and will be provided to Committee members under separate cover. The report is also available for review in the Wastewater and Drainage Engineering office, 9th floor City Hall.

Discussion:

The Drainage Act requires a public meeting prior to the adoption of the Engineer's Report. This Committee Meeting will serve that purpose. All assessed property owners have been notified of this meeting and may be present to express their concerns or pose questions. There is a further opportunity to appeal their assessment prior to construction through the Court of

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Revision, scheduled for November 22, 2011.


Representatives of Spriet Associates London Limited will be at the meeting to answer any questions regarding the Drainage Report.



A By-law to provide for the reconstruction of drainage works in the City of London - the Glanworth Municipal Drain-2011, reconstruction of the Main Drain and Branches "A", "B" and "C" is under Section 78 and Branch "E" is under Section 4. The area requiring Drainage for Branch "E" is the north part of Lot 15, Concession 8 (former Westminster)

WHEREAS the Glanworth Municipal Drain-2011, being By-law DR-68, was passed by the City of London Council, pursuant to the *Drainage Act* (now R.S.O. 1990, c.D. 17);

AND WHEREAS the lands referred to in the above-mentioned by-laws are now included in the City of London;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council wishes to reconstruct these drainage works as set out in this by-law, pursuant to section 84 of the *Drainage Act*;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. The Glanworth Municipal Drain-2011, as identified on the map attached as Schedule "A", are hereby reconstructed.
2. The Corporation of the City of London, pursuant to subsection 84(5) of the *Drainage Act*, has no further obligation with respect to the drainage works mentioned in section 1 of this by-law.
3. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
