









Nuisance Party

 A <u>social gathering</u> on premises within the municipality and which, by reason of the <u>conduct of persons in attendance</u>, results in any <u>one or more</u> of the following activities occurring that constitute a public nuisance whether occurring on <u>neighbouring public or</u> <u>private property</u>:



- · disorderly conduct;
- public drunkenness; urination;
- the unlawful distribution of alcohol;
- littering; noise; open burning;
- · destruction of property;
- obstruction of emergency services;
- brewfing (2017)



 No person shall sponsor, conduct, continue, host, create, attend, allow, cause or permit a Nuisance Party.
