SUBJECT	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW PERRY STREET & HORN STREET

RECOMMENDATION

That on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Environmental & Engineering Services and City Engineer, the attached proposed by-law (Appendix "A") BE INTRODUCED at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on November 20, 2012 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S. 111) with respect to reverting Perry Street and Horn Street to one-way roads.

BACKGROUND

Due to the construction activity in 2012 on Stanley Street a conversion of Perry Street and Horn Street from one-way operation to two-way operation and the removal of on-street parking was required so that residents could access their properties. On April 10, 2012 Municipal Council approved the by-law amending the Traffic & Parking By-law to accommodate these changes.

The reconstruction of Stanley Street is nearing completion and the one-way designation/onstreet parking can be reinstated. Amendments to Schedule 2 (No Parking, Schedule 6 (Limited Parking) and Schedule 12 (One-Way Streets) of the Traffic & Parking By-law (PS 111) are required to return Perry Street and Horn Street to their pre-construction designations.



APPENDIX "A" BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (P.S. 111)

Bill No.

By-law No. PS-111

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;
