I was a board member of LACAC (the precursor to LACH) 1993-5.

Also I was on the Mayor's Downtown Action Team for Heritage 1997-99 and participated in the 'Mainstreet' initiative for Dundas St at that time. I designed, wrote and raised the funding for the 'Downtown Discovery Trail' first produced in 1998. wrote a chapter on historic hotels for 'Layers of Time' in 1998.
