I YOUR COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS:

London Block Parent® Program Strategic Plan 2013-2016 1. (3) That the Municipal Council **BE REQUESTED** to consider a \$21,000 2013 Budget increase, to the London Block Parent® Program, per year for 3 years, to accommodate the additional office hours and staff required to provide the new re-screening process to its Block Parent families; it being noted that the London Police Services previously provided this service for the Block Parent® Program; it being further noted that the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Advisory Committee (CSCP) reviewed and received a communication and heard the attached presentation from G. McMahon, London Block Parent®, with respect to this matter.

2nd Report of the CSCP 2. (1) That the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Advisory Committee (CSCP) received and noted the 2nd Report of the CSCP from its meeting held on October 31, 2012.

City of London R-Zone* Program 3. (2) That the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Advisory Committee (CSCP) reviewed and received a communication and heard the attached presentation from T. Kyle, Manager, West Area Recreation Services and L. Loubert, Division Manager, Aquatics, Arenas and Attractions, with respect to the proposed City of London R-Zone* Program. The CSCP indicated that it supports, in principle, the proposed R-Zone* Program for use in the City's recreation facilities, events and programs.

YMCA Children's Safety Village – Funding Request 4. (4) That the Community Safety and Crime Prevention Advisory Committee (CSCP) reviewed and received a communication dated November 2012, from S. Brooks, Manager, YMCA Children's Safety Village, with respect to a funding request for the purchase of a heavy duty laptop computer for the Police Classroom and for the supply of fire education colouring books to be provided to each child attending JK to Grade 1. The CSCP approved the expenditure for up to \$1,500 for a laptop computer and up to \$1,500 for colouring books, from its 2012 budget allocation; it being noted that the CSCP has sufficient funds in its 2012 budget for this expenditure.
