By-law No.

A by-law with respect to a Service Manager Agreement for the Community Homelessness Preventative Initiative

WHEREAS section 2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that municipalities are created by the Province of Ontario to be responsible and accountable governments with respect to matters within their jurisdiction and each municipality is given powers and duties under this Act and many other Acts for the purpose of providing good government with respect to those matters;

AND WHEREAS section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that the City may provide any service or thing that the City considers necessary or desirable for the public, and may pass by-laws respecting same, and respecting economic, social and environmental well-being of the City, and the health, safety and well-being of persons;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. A Service Manager Agreement, substantially in the form attached as Schedule 1 to this by-law, for the Community Homelessness Preventative Initiative, between The Corporation of the City of London and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, is hereby authorized and approved.
2. The Managing Director, Neighbourhood, Children & Fire Services, or designate, is hereby delegated authority to execute the Agreement authorized and approved under section 1, above.
3. The Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative Investment Plan, substantially in the form attached as Schedule 2 to this by-law, is hereby authorized and approved for submission to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.
4. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
