- ii. Staff **BE DIRECTED** to make revisions based on Community, Committee and Council feedback and to return to a future meeting of the Investment and Economic Prosperity Committee with an update.

BACKGROUND

This report addresses the 49 economic prosperity proposals presented to the Investment and Economic Prosperity Committee in 2012. All proponents were asked to complete a due diligence checklist; 12 checklists were returned. Checklists were reviewed using a business centred approach focused on economic development. Five recommendations are identified within this report to move forward in the process. Also through this process, Corporate Communications is developing a communications strategy under the leadership of Veronica McAlea Major and the Intergovernmental and Community Liaison Office is developing a plan to secure funding from higher levels of government under the leadership of Grant Hopcroft.
