RE: Monthly Report for November 2012

Attached are the Building Division's monthly report for November 2012 and copies of the Summary of the Inspectors' Workload reports.

Permit Issuance

By the end of November, 4,044 permits had been issued with a construction value of approximately \$748.3 million dollars, representing 1,802 new dwelling units. Compared to last year, this represents a 8.9% increase in the number of permits, a 10.6% decrease in the construction value and a 51.9% increase in the number of dwelling units.

To the end of November, the number of single and semi detached dwellings issued were 742, which was a 10.1% increase over last year.

At the end of November, there were 307 applications in process, representing approximately \$65.9 million dollars in construction value and an additional 289 dwelling units, compared with 326 applications having a construction value of \$167 million dollars and an additional 606 dwelling units for the same period last year.

The rate of incoming applications for the month of November averaged out to 14.4 applications a day for a total of 316 in 22 working days. There were 50 permit applications to build 50 new single detached dwellings, 13 townhouse applications to build 32 units, 6 of which were cluster single dwelling units.

There were 298 permits issued in November totalling \$37,158,950 including 72 new dwelling units.

Inspections

Although multiple inspections may be booked and completed for a project on the same day (ie. structural framing and HVAC rough-in), only one inspection is counted in this report. This provides a more accurate depiction of the inspectors' workload.

Building Inspectors received 1,422 inspection calls and conducted 1,784 building permit related inspections with an additional 34 inspections completed relating to complaints, licenses, orders and miscellaneous inspections. This is a total of 1,818 inspections or an average of 182 inspections made per inspector this month based on 9 inspectors*, which averages out to 9.3 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 220 person working days – 25.5 vac/sick day/training = 194.5. There are a total of 9,795 active building permits or an average of 980 permits per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 99.5% of the time.

Plumbing Inspectors received 726 inspection calls and conducted a total of 894 permit related inspections, there were 10 inspections performed that related to the Backflow Prevention Program. Inspections relating to complaints, orders and miscellaneous calls totalled a further 1 inspections. During the month, a total of 905 inspections were conducted with an average of 181 per inspector, which averages out to 9.2 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 110 person working days — 9 vac/sick day/training = 101). Active building permits involving plumbing totalled 3,332 or 666 on average per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 99.0% of the time.

*During the month of November, one building inspector was assigned office duties (no field inspections).
