SUBJECT	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW

### RECOMMENDATION


That on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Environmental & Engineering Services and City Engineer, the <u>attached</u> proposed by-law (Appendix "A") **BE INTRODUCED** at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on January 29, 2013 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S. 111).

# BACKGROUND

The Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S.111) requires amendments (Appendix "A") to address traffic safety, operations and parking concerns. The following amendments are proposed:

#### 1. No Parking

- a) Due to pedestrian safety concerns on Chippewa Drive in front of Chippewa Public School, it is proposed to create a limited 8 am 9 am and 2 pm 4 pm Monday to Friday, September to June, No Stopping zone on the north side of Chippewa Drive along the school's property. Concerns have been expressed that students are crossing the road in places other than at a pedestrian crosswalk after being dropped off or for pick-up. An amendment is required to Schedule 1 (No Stopping).
- b) A mail-back survey was conducted on Farnsborough Crescent to determine if the homeowners supported extension of a "No Parking Anytime" zone (north side) and 1 Hour Parking, 8 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday zone (south side) from existing limits (north end of the street) to Langton Road. The results of the mail-back survey indicated that the majority of respondents supported the parking regulations change. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking) and Schedule 6 (Limited Parking).
- c) A mail-back survey was conducted on Garland Lane to determine if the homeowners supported creating a "No Parking Anytime" zone on the south/east side from Garland Crescent (north intersection) to a point 97 meters westerly. The results of the mail-back survey indicated that the majority of respondents supported the parking regulations change. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).
- d) Parking bays were recently constructed on the north side of Hamilton Road between Maitland Street and Bathurst Street. Parking should be prohibited in the narrow areas of the street. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).
- e) Due to ongoing safety concerns with narrow road width, it is necessary to prohibit parking on one side of Stephen Street between Helena Montague Avenue and Springbank Avenue. Currently the west side of the street is signed with "1 Hour Parking, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday-Friday" signs between Helena Montague Ave and Springbank Ave and there parking is permitted all day on the east side of the road. A review of the street concluded that parking should be prohibited on the west side, which would allow parking on the east side adjacent to the sidewalk. A mail-back survey was conducted on Stephen Street to determine if the homeowners would want "1 Hour Parking, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday-Friday" zone on the east side of Stephen Street between Helena Montague Ave and Springbank Ave or unrestricted parking. The results of the mail-back survey indicated low response rate; therefore, the unrestricted parking maintained on the east side of the street. Amendments are required to Schedule 2 (No Parking) to prohibit parking on the west side of the street.



#### 2. Regulatory Signs

a) Due to ongoing safety concerns with respect to intersection of Townsend Drive and Blackmaple Drive controlled by yield sign, it is proposed to replace it with stop sign. Amendments are required to Schedule 10 (Entering Highway – Stop Signs) and Schedule 11 (Entering Highway – Yield Signs).

#### 3. Monthly Parking Permits

The City's Parking Enforcement Office has requested a by-law amendment of Part 2 "Metered Parking" Section 56 (d) to formalize the current practice of allowing multiple licence plated vehicles to use the same permit.



# APPENDIX "A" BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (P.S. 111)

Bill No.

By-law No. PS-111

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

#### 1. No Stopping

Schedule "1" (No Stopping) of the said By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by **adding** the following row:




#### 6. Part 2 - Metered Parking

Part 2 - Metered Parking, Section 56 Monthly Parking Permits, sub-section (d) of the said Bylaw PS-111 is hereby amended by deleting the following:

that the permit is valid for the licence plated vehicle identified by the owner at the time of purchase of the permit and is not transferable to any other vehicle.

#### And by adding the following:

d) that the permit is valid for the licence plated vehicle(s) identified by the owner at the time of purchase of the permit and all licence plate(s) must have ownership(s) registered to the same address and are not transferable.



7. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
