I am writing on behalf of my company Runners Feed to request a municipal resolution in order to apply for a Special Occasion Permit to host a Beer Garden following the Rock the Road 10K in London Ontario on Sunday August 18th, 2013 in the Masonville Mall parking lot. More specifically, we are looking to have our event fall under the Municipally Significant Event category.

My name is Brandon Laan and I am an *Internet* entrepreneur, coach, and elite runner. I have a genuine interest in bettering the London Community by bridging the gap between the sport industry and commerce. I spent my undergraduate days at Western University where I captained the Cross Country Team before attending graduate school at Hawaii Pacific University. I am deeply immersed in the Canadian running community as President of <u>RaceRoster.com</u>, and as an elite runner (2011 Canadian Marathon Championships-Silver Medalist).

Our team has a vision of reestablishing London as a running destination. Our ultimate goal is to create a high caliber event that would become a staple race for Londoners as well as a huge tourism attraction for runners abroad.
