SUBJECT	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW

RECOMMENDATION

That on the recommendation of the Managing Director, Environmental & Engineering Services and City Engineer, the <u>attached</u> proposed by-law (Appendix "A") **BE INTRODUCED** at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on January 29, 2013 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S. 111).

BACKGROUND

The Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S.111) requires amendments (Appendix "A") to address traffic safety, operations and parking concerns. The following amendments are proposed:

1. No Stopping, No Parking

a) Currently a No Stopping Anytime zone is designated within a School Bus Loading zone in front of Tweedsmuir Public School on Tweedsmuir Avenue. Normally No Stopping zones within School Bus Loading zones are time limited and are not required before or after school hours. It is proposed to replace current No Stopping Anytime zone with No Stopping 8 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday, September to June. It is also necessary to add No Parking Anytime zone on Tweedsmuir Avenue along the school's frontage to be consistent with the requirement of section 10 (No Parking in posted locations) of By-law PS-111 which prohibits parking upon that side of the street and immediately adjacent to any school property. Amendments are required to Schedule 1 (No Stopping) and Schedule 2(No Parking).


2. Loading Zone

a) Limits of existing loading zone on the south side of Queens Avenue east of Richmond Street should be revised to help prevent vehicles from parking in front of an existing fire hydrant. An amendment is required to Schedule 5 (Loading Zones).

3. Bicycle Lanes

- a) New bicycle lanes were installed on following streets:
 - Cheapside Street between Highbury Avenue and Fanshawe College Boulevard;
 - Sarnia Road from Aldersbrook Road to a point 100 m east of Oakcrossing Gate;
 and
 - White Oak Road from Dingman Drive to a point 110 m north of Blackie Road

Amendments are required to Schedule 9.1 (Reserved Lanes)



4. Metered Parking

- a) The management of Centennial Hall expressed concerns that there is insufficient space in front of Centennial Hall for patrons to stop and pick-up their tickets. In order to address this concern, existing parking meters will be removed from the drive around area in front of 550 Wellington Street (Centennial Hall). The existing "2 Hour, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Metered Parking" zone will be replaced with "15 minutes, 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Parking" zone. Amendments are required to Schedule 6 (Limited Parking) and Schedule 20 (2 Hour Metered Parking).
- b) As part of the 2012 Horton Street Rehabilitation Project, parking bays were constructed on both sides of the road between Henry Street and Waterloo Street. In order to ensure parking is available for customers of nearby businesses and to ensure the parking stalls are not occupied by all-day downtown parkers, parking meters should be installed. These meters would be operational from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm with a 2 hour limit. An amendment is required to Schedule 20 (2 Hour Metered Parking).
- c) Bathurst Street between Waterloo Street and Colborne Street has 4 hour limited parking and Colborne Street to Burwell Street there is no time limit. It is proposed to change these areas to 10 hour metered parking similar to Bathurst Street west of Wellington Street. Amendments are required to Schedule 6 (Limited Parking) and Schedule 21.1 (10 Hour Metered Parking).

5. Typographical errors

A review of the by-law found typographical errors. Changes are required to address the following:

- a) Hour of operation of metered parking of Bathurst Street from 43 m east of Talbot Street to 93 m west of Clarence Street should be 8:00 am to 6:00 pm;
- b) Reference to Catherine Street east of Veterans Memorial Parking should be changed to River Road; and
- c) Queens Avenue bicycle lane direction.

An amendment is required to Schedule 9.1 (Reserved Lanes), Schedule 13 (Through Highways), Schedule 15 (Reduced Load Limits) and Schedule 21.1 (10 Hour Metered Parking).






