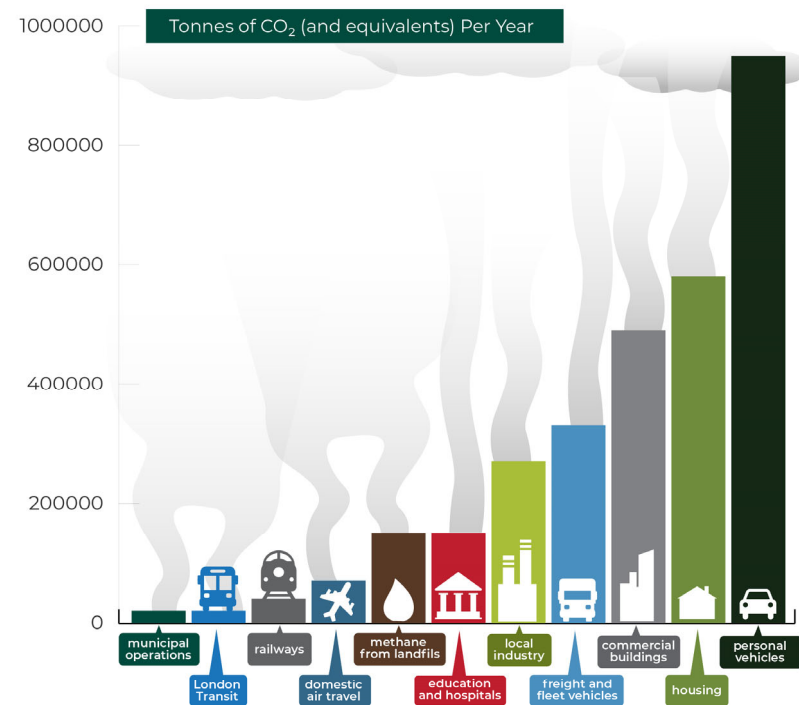

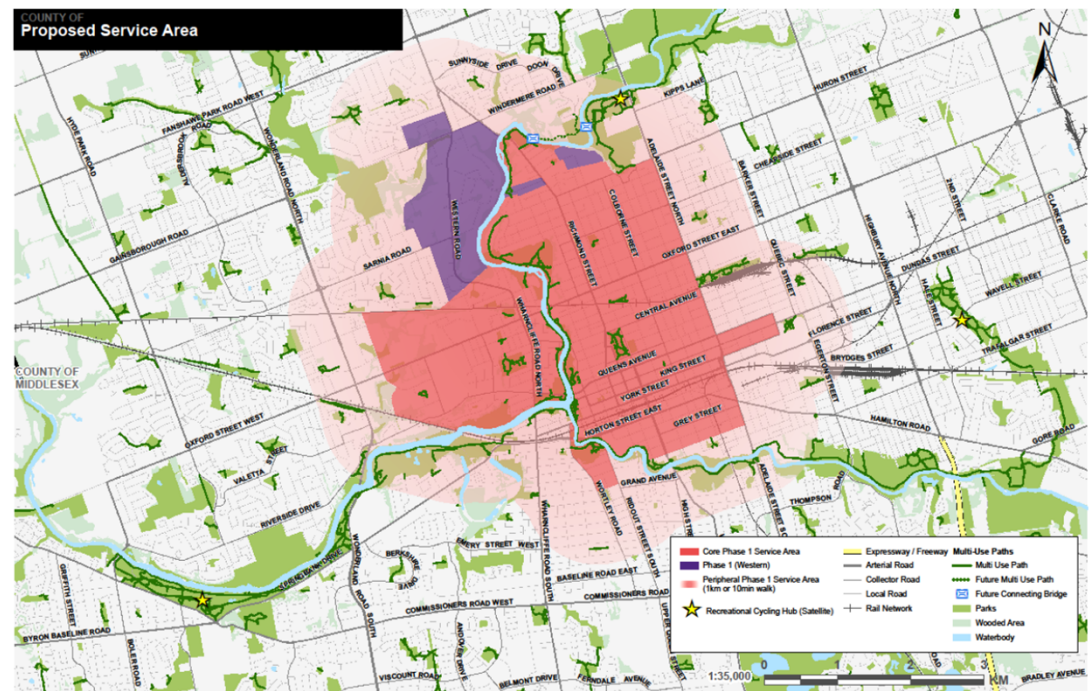
Total greenhouse gas emissions from London have decreased compared to the “peak” in 2007. In 2019, greenhouse gas emissions were 21 percent lower than 2007.

 - Preferred bike rack styles
 - Recommended site planning
- For use by City staff and contractors
- CAC and others input Q1/early Q2 2021
- Finalized Q2 2021

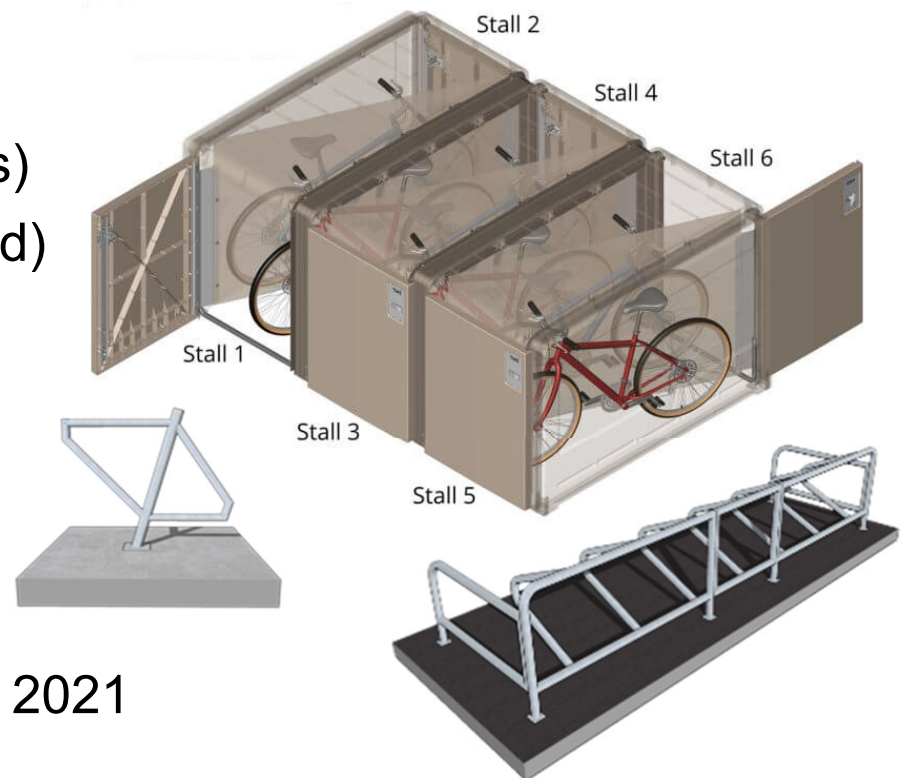
