To: Chair and Members of the Planning and Environment Committee,

Please consider the following points before making your final decision:

- 8,400 community members will be impacted by your decision (1998 Sunningdale Plan estimate).
 Restricting access will result in muliple entries and more environmental damage.
- 2. Phase 1 of the pathway, North of Fanshawe Park Road to the Sunningdale subdivision, has high community usage. The city measured 2,900 users just in the month of Nov. 2012.
- 3. Claims of habitat fragmentation were made but no measurable data was presented.
- 4. Almost all residents voted to have a continuous trail/pathway system to connect communities.
- 5. Hiking and cycling along Sunningdale Road are considered unsafe alternatives for recreation.
- 6. Residents voted decisively (72%) to use a 50/50 environmental/social criteria weighting in the evaluation process. The original Public Advisory Committee is still pushing for 75/25 weighting.
- 7. Restricting access to the Medway Valley will severely limit the passive recreation opportunities expected by thousands of residents in this high growth area.
