SUBJECT:	CONTRACT AWARD – TENDER NO. 11-67 2011 SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – FITZWILLIAM BOULEVARD (ES2464, ES5424)			

### RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Director, Wastewater and Treatment, Planning, Environmental and Engineering Services, the following actions **BE TAKEN** with respect to the award of a contract for the construction of Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project (ES2464, ES5424):

- (a) the bid submitted by TRI-CON Excavating Inc., 113-4023 Meadowbrook Drive, London, ON, N6L 1E7, at its tendered price of \$309,686.70 excluding H.S.T., for the construction of the Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project, BE ACCEPTED; it being pointed out that the bid submitted by TRI-CON Excavating Inc. was the lowest of 6 bids received and meets the City's specifications and requirements in all areas;
- (b) minor future additional annual operating costs of \$400.00 BE RECOGNIZED as a result of this project noting that these costs are as a result of new infrastructure installation and will be considered and accommodated within future Wastewater & Treatment operating budgets;
- (c) the financing for this project **BE APPROVED** as set out in the Sources of Financing Report <u>attached</u> hereto as Appendix "A";
- (d) the Civic Administration **BE AUTHORIZED** to undertake all the administrative acts that are necessary in connection with this project; and
- (e) the approval given herein **BE CONDITIONAL** upon the Corporation entering into a formal contract for the material to be supplied and the work to be done relating to this project (Tender 11-67); and
- (f) the Mayor and City Clerk **BE AUTHORIZED** to execute any contract or other documents, if required, to give effect to these recommendations.

## PREVIOUS REPORTS PERTINENT TO THIS MATTER

### **BACKGROUND**

Purpose:

This report recommends award of tender to the low bid contractor for the construction of the Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project. This work includes upsizing of an existing sanitary sewer and installation of new sanitary sewers, along with road replacement with new curb and gutters.

#### **Discussion:**

The Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project is being undertaken to remove a hydraulic constraint (flow restriction) and increase capacity in the Fitzwilliam sewer system. Homes along the bottom of Fitzwilliam Boulevard have experienced basement flooding in the past due to sanitary sewer back up during storm events. The sanitary sewers in the area are susceptible to inflow and infiltration of storm water. Through investigation and analysis it was

determined that the risk of basement flooding can be reduced by increasing the capacity of the sewers and removing the hydraulic constraint. The construction program also includes the replacement of the asphalt around the Hunt Club Pumping Station and within the project area along Fitzwilliam Boulevard including part of the curb and gutter.

In conjunction with the construction of this project, the City is administering the Private Drain Connection (PDC) program which allows homeowners within the projects limits an opportunity to voluntarily replace their PDC's at a subsidized cost under the authority of City By-laws.

The scope of work generally involves the following:

- Upsizing 57m of sanitary sewer on Fitzwilliam Boulevard from 300mm to 450mm diameter.
- Twinning the 65m sanitary sewer along the access road to the Hunt Club Pumping Station
- Installing a new manhole at the intersection of the access road with Fitzwilliam Boulevard to separate the conflicting flows.
- Reconstruction of 57m of Fitzwilliam Boulevard including road structure and curb and gutter along the southerly portion.
- Reconstruction of the asphalt along the access road to the Hunt Club Pumping Station

This project has been surveyed, designed, and drafted by City Staff. All supervision and contract administration will also be conducted by City Staff.

The construction schedule identifies a tentative start date of August 30, 2011 and 25 working days to complete the project.

**Tender Summary:** 

Tenders for the construction of the Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvement project were opened on July 20, 2011.

Six (6) contractors submitted tenders as follows (exclusive of H.S.T.):

All tenders have been checked by the Environmental and Engineering Services Department. None of the tender bids contained mathematical errors.

The tender estimate just prior to tender opening was \$334,241.00, including a contingency of \$30,000.00 (excluding H.S.T.).

Minor future additional annual operating costs of \$400.00 are recognized as a result of this project noting that these costs are attributed to new infrastructure installation and will be considered and accommodated within future Wastewater & Treatment operating budgets.

#### Recommendations:

It is recommended that TRI-CON Excavating Inc. be awarded the contract for the construction of the Fitzwilliam Boulevard Sanitary Sewer Improvements.
