Entrepreneurial Programs

- The SBC has a number of contracts with various levels of government to deliver entrepreneurial training to individuals as a back to work strategy.
- Individual must meet strict gov't eligibility requirements to participate, often based on demographic criteria.



Entrepreneurial Programs

 Inherent in all programs is the core belief that a well researched and thought out business plan increases an individual's chance of success. All programs have in-depth business planning workshops, one-on-one advisory support and an element of income/financial support.



Entrepreneurial Programs

- Program funding partners include The Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities; The City of London Ontario Works; The Ministry of Economic Development, Trade and Employment; Service Canada.
- Collectively 125-150 businesses will launch each year, with the assistance of the programs. 3X that amount will begin the application process and receive guidance and training.



Entrepreneurial Services

- Unlike Programs, Services are available to everyone.
- Funded by the City of London, The Ministry of Economic Development, Trade and Employment, corporate sponsorship and user fees.
- Supported by over 20 corporate sponsors.
