London has been my home for 65 years. Historic and important buildings have been demolished, a few have been moved to Fanshawe Pioneer Village, others have been hidden within modern structures. This latest proposal should not be allowed to proceed.

I am concerned with the dominating nature of this development proposal. It would loom over and dwarf the Ridout Street Complex, one of London's few National Historic Sites. It would dominate the sightlines and public space associated with Harris Park and the Forks of the Thames, the historic heart of our City. The large addition built by John Labatt Limited as part of the original restoration was and is sympathetic to the historic streetscape. This proposed development is anything but sympathetic. I urge City Councillors to reject the Official Plan and zoning by-law amendment application.
