Please include my comments on the PEC agenda package for the meeting where this matter will be discussed.

I am writing to express my support for the *Conservation Master Plan Phase II for the Medway Valley Heritage Forest ESA (South),* dated June 2021. I also support the related amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning by-law.

I have a long-standing interest in protection of London's Environmentally Significant Areas, and I am very familiar with the Medway Valley Heritage Forest.

- Section 1.2.2 of the Conservation Master Plan (CMP) presents the Guiding Principles behind the
 development of the CMP. It is important to keep these principles front and centre when
 considering the plan. A key principle is this one: "The ecological integrity and ecosystem health
 of the ESA shall have priority in any use or design-related decision." The current CMP appears to
 be consistent with this principle.
- Section 3.4.3.7 describes the steps that will be taken to address trails that are being closed. I
 urge council to provide sufficient budget resources to enable this work. Having watched efforts
 to close trails in other ESAs in London, it seems very difficult to convince trail users to change
 their habits. It is even more challenging when the steps described here are not fully
 implemented.
- Section 4.2.3.6 discusses seasonal closure of a trail for the protection of at-risk plants. While
 this approach is commendable, I wonder whether trail users will respect the closure? This
 closure will be difficult to enforce.

In conclusion, I support this Conservation Master Plan. I urge council to adopt the CMP, and to approve the associated planning amendments.
