

Eldon House Background

- Built in 1834 by John and Amelia Harris
- Home to four generations of the Harris family until 1959
- Gifted to the City of London effective January 1, 1961
- Managed by Museum London since 1989; previously managed by the London Public Library
- Eldon House Corporation established as a municipal service board through By-law 6825-162 on May 22, 2012
- The 5-person Eldon House Corporation Board of Directors appointed August 28, 2012
- Eldon House Board assumed stewardship on January 1, 2013
