I YOUR COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Tree Conservation By-law

1. That the Trees and Forests Advisory Committee (TFAC) heard a verbal delegation from N. Kapp, East Park Golf Course and T. Webb, Sunningdale Golf Club, relating to golf courses and the City's Tree Conservation By-law.
