What do you hope to contribute or learn as part of a Community Advisory Committee? (max. 250 characters: I have a long term interest in local history. My latest and perhaps my last project is entitled "London's First Fifty Years" and is a survey of buildings with photographs and descriptions of the importance of the buildings, including architectural, from the early days of the city. It surveys both buildings that still exist and some for whom their remains only a site and photographs.

I have over the years been involved in many historical research projects involving research, documentation and in some cases successful preservation of buildings and grave sites. While I was teaching I local history in the classroom I worked with a committee on two books that provided tours along with maps that were used by teachers taking classes on local history field trips.

In term of contribution, I think I could contribute a good knowledge of London's geography and history. I also have an extensive personal library of books, maps and documents that might prove beneficial for others.

But I do not believe nor would I support the saving of old buildings at all costs. I personally believe that the biggest and most challenging issue facing all cities, including London is in dealing with climate change, in many and complex ways. I would say that my first support will be to any planning designed to address that issue.

I have also coached in community sports including soccer, basketball, golf, tennis, track and field. I am an avid golfer and have been an active member of London's public golf courses for over twenty years.

As a teacher, in addition to performing regular classroom duties, I have worked on curriculum preparation committees in science, history and English, planned and supervised field trips, written curriculum documents, organized sporting events and tournaments and organized history and science fairs.
