# Fanshawe Park Road and Richmond Street Intersection Improvements



#### Project Background

A Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) was completed for the Fanshawe Park Road and Richmond Street intersection in March 2019, recommending improvements to the intersection, including the provision of dual left turn lanes, as well as improved cycling and pedestrian connections.





## **Existing Conditions**

The existing intersection is a signalized stop intersection with two through lanes in each direction, dedicated left turn lanes and a mix of dedicated and shared through-right turn lanes, including median separated lanes.

Sidewalks and bike lanes are provided, but not continuously through each corridor.






#### Construction Limits

- Richmond Street from Jacksway Crescent to North Centre Road






## Typical Cross Section: Fanshawe Park Road






# Typical Cross Section: Richmond Street






#### Proposed Improvements: Fanshawe Park Road






#### RioCan/Masonville Entrance








#### North Centre Road – East Limits






#### North Centre Road – West Limits






#### Proposed Improvements: Richmond Street






#### North Centre Road - North Limits





#### Jacksway Crescent - South Limits




