These conditions demand immediate attention and action. We want our home and our lives back. Please find a way to quickly determine if 89 Wilson Ave is indeed a heritage home, and if it is not than please allow us the necessary permits we need to turn this house back into a home. I do not believe that what we have asked is an outrageous or unattainable goal. Please consider how difficult this has been for us.
